Alternative Class A Program

The CEPS offers Alternative Class A Programs for students who completed a non-teaching degree or students who want to change teaching fields. Completion of the Alternative Class A program leads to the Master's degree and recommendation for Master's-level Alabama Class A professional educator certification.

Alabama Professional Educator Certificates

The Alabama Professional Educator Certificate licenses an individual to teach in the Alabama Public School System. Alabama has three classes of Professional Educator Certification: Class B, Class A, and Class AA. Individuals may apply for the Class B certificate after completing a bachelor's-level teacher education program; the Class A certificate after completing a master's-level teacher education program; and the Class AA certificate after completing an education specialist program. Each class has a different pay structure, which varies by county.
