- An earned Master's degree from an institutionally accredited institution.
- 4. Official transcripts from the baccalaureate degree awarding institution and all transcripts from institutions where post-baccalaureate work has been completed. To be considered for admission, applications must hold a degree from an institutionally accredited institution or its foreign equivalent. (Students who have previously attended JSU do not need to request a transcript from the university.)
- 5. An updated résumé or CV.
- 6. Writing sample that includes the following: (1) the applicant's rationale for applying for the EdD; (2) a statement regarding career/ professional goals; AND (3) an opinion-based writing sample of no more than 1,500 words describing a current and critical social or cultural problem, how it impacts your area of interest in education, and possible solutions.
