Application Deadlines

Rolling Admissions. Applications are accepted throughout the year as admissions must be met before the anticipated start term.

Application Materials Required for the MS with a Major in Emergency Management

Applicants for the MS with a major in Emergency Management must submit all of the following documentation to Graduate Admissions to be considered for admission:

- 3. Official transcripts from the baccalaureate degree awarding institution and all transcripts from institutions where post-baccalaureate work has been completed. To be considered for admission, applicants must hold a degree from an institutionally accredited institution or its foreign equivalent. (Students who have previously attended JSU do not need to request a transcript from the university.)

Admission Requirements for the MS with a Major in Emergency Management

A particular undergraduate major is not specified for admission to the program. Applicants must meet one of the following requirements:

Unconditional Admission

 Applicants with an undergraduate GPA of 3.00 or higher from a institutionally accredited institution may be unconditionally admitted.

Conditional Admission

- Applicants with an undergraduate GPA of 2.50 to 2.99 from a institutionally accredited institution may be conditionally admitted.
- Any applicant with an undergraduate GPA below 2.50 who wishes to be considered for conditional admission must submit a professional resume that includes an academic history, employment information, and any voluntary/community work.
- Applicants who are awarded the Emergency Management (Graduate Certificate) program at Jacksonville State University prior to seeking admission to the MS with a major in Emergency Management program may have the minimum 2.5 undergraduate GPA admission requirement waived for conditional admission.

Applicants who are granted conditional admission must achieve a GPA of at least 3.00 on the first 12 graduate hours attempted. Failure to meet

these conditions will result in the student being dropped from graduate studies.

Minimum Requirements for the MS with a Major in Emergency Management

An overall 3.00 GPA is required on all coursework attempted for the master's degree. Transfer credit cannot be used to raise the GPA to the required 3.00.

A total of 30 graduate semester hours is required for the degree with 21 required hours of emergency management courses and nine hours of approved emergency management electives.
