

# INTERNATIONAL HOUSE/ PROGRAMS (IHP)

## **IHP 310 Global Ambassadors (0)**

Prerequisite(s): Permission of Director of International House and Programs required.

Global Ambassadors study the JSU community, International House, and International Programs, JSU history and traditions, American and world cultures, preparing them for service as mentors for international students and student leaders in the internationalization of the JSU campus community. Course may be repeated up to 6 times. Grades: Pass/No Credit.

## **IHP 398 Study Abroad Participation (0)**

Students planning to study abroad for a semester or shorter duration in order to gain an international educational experience may enroll in IHP 398. This is a non-credit course to indicate that the student has completed study abroad experience on his/her transcript. The course can be repeated up to three times to reflect completion of a study abroad program. Students returning after completion of a study abroad program with JSU affiliate providers will need to submit an official transcript for the assignment of JSU credits. Affiliate providers are partner institutions and/or third-party providers with whom JSU has formal agreements. Students returning after completion of a study abroad program with non-affiliate providers will need to submit official transcripts and/or course by course evaluation on international transcript for the award of JSU credits. Transfer of credits for students taking study abroad trip with non-affiliate providers may not be guaranteed. May be repeated for a total of four times.

## **IHP 399 Study Abroad (1-18)**

Prerequisite(s): Approval by Study Abroad office.

(1 -18). Students planning to study abroad for a semester or shorter duration in order to gain an international educational experience may enroll in IHP 399 from 1-18 credit hours. Topics, excursions, and requirements are determined by program and/or by partner institutions and/or third-party provider that JSU has agreements with. Advance deposit and approval by Study Abroad office required. Students returning after completion of a study abroad program with JSU affiliate providers, will need to submit an official transcript for the assignment of JSU credits. Affiliate providers are partner institutions and/or third-party provider with whom JSU has formal agreements. Students returning after completion of a study abroad program with non-affiliate providers will need to submit an official transcript and/or course by course evaluation on an international transcript for the award of JSU credits. Transfer of credits for students completing study abroad program with non-affiliate providers may not be guaranteed. This course may be repeated up to three times.

## **IHP 400 Global Ambassadors Leadership (0)**

Prerequisite(s): IHP 310 and/or permission of Director of International House and Programs required.

Global Ambassadors Leadership offers students with international life or work experience to study JSU's history, customs, and student services, deepen their understanding of world cultures, lead and mentor other students, and assist in internationalization of the campus. Course may be repeated up to 4 times. Grades: Pass/No Credit.
